**PROBE OF HIGH PROFILE CASES**

(a) whether National Investigation Agency (NIA) is able to probe the high profile cases affecting the sovereignty, security and integrity of India, etc. handed over to it/taken by it in a time bound manner without any unnecessary delay for which it was established through an Act in the year 2008; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (b): Yes, Sir. Government has handed over 56 cases to National Investigation Agency (NIA) for investigation. The details of cases handed over to NIA year-wise is as under:-

Out of 56 cases, 29 cases have been charge sheeted and in 02 cases trial have been completed, wherein 02 terrorist were convicted. Out of 25 cases under investigation, 22 cases have been solved and are at the various stages of investigation. Three cases are yet to be solved.
