- (b) whether their activities have hurt the economy in this region;**
- (c) if so, the State-wise details thereof; and**
- (d) the steps Government proposes to take to address the threat of terrorism in the North-East?**

**STATEMENT IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 160 FOR 03.12.2014.**

**(a): The details of major militant/insurgent outfits operating in the North-Eastern Region are annexed as Annexure-I.**

**(b) & (c) : The most of militant/insurgent groups have been indulging in illegal/unlawful activities viz. extortions, kidnapping for ransom, killings and attacking infrastructural installations etc. This has impacted the developmental activities adversely in the North East India.**

**(d) : The Central Government is supplementing the efforts of the State Government to control the militancy and curb the extortion and unlawful activities perpetrated by militant/insurgent groups of North Eastern States in a coordinated way which, inter alia, include deployment of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF), Central assistance to the State Governments for modernization of State Police Forces, sanction of India Reserve Battalions, banning the Unlawful Associations under Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, declaring specific areas/states as 'disturbed areas' under Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, issuing notification for Unified Command Structure and setting up of Anti-extortion Cells in the NE States etc. Besides, Government has been pursuing a policy of talks/negotiations with any outfit which showed willingness to abjure path of violence. As a result, a number of militant groups have surrendered after laying down arms. Sustained counter-insurgency operations are continuing against the insurgent groups who are indulging in violent activities.**
