CCTV CAMERAS IN DELHI

1187. DR. C. GOPALAKRISHNAN:

Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of new CCTVs cameras installed during the visit of US President in the NCT of Delhi;

(b) whether it is a fact that all these installed CCTV cameras have been removed after the departure of the US President;

(c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons for removing these installed CCTVs; and

(d) the total funds spent for installation and removing of all these CCTV cameras?

(a) to (d): Delhi Police has informed that 605 CCTV Cameras were hired in connection with the visit of US President as well as for Republic Day arrangements for security purpose, during the month of January, 2015. All the CCTV cameras have been removed after the function. An amount of Rs. 1,36,58,149/- have been spent on hiring, installation and removal of these CCTV Cameras.
