(c) : The vacancies are arisen out of retirements, resignations, new raising etc, which is a routine ongoing administrative process. Timely action is taken to fill up the vacancies by direct recruitment, by promotion or by deputation as per the Recruitment Rules. The vacancies remained unfilled due to any reason including non-joining of the candidates selected for the post are carried forward to the next vacancy year in the same category.
