Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has any proposal to keep Swayam Sewaks in Police Control Room (PCR) van by the Delhi Police; and

(b) if so, the details thereof and the time by which such proposal is likely to be approved?

(a) to (b): Delhi Police has informed that they have initiated a sustainable youth police partnership project call "YUVA PRAHARI" with the Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS). Under the project, screened and trained NYKS volunteers perform duties in Delhi Police's PCR Vans deployed around the areas of residence of these volunteers. In the pilot phase, a batch of 126 volunteers (35 female and 91 male) have been given basic training in emergency handling like self-defence, first aid and a basic orientation to the working of the PCR system and inducted in to the PCR vans on 3rd January, 2015.
