CHANGE OF NAME OF STATIONS

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the State Government of Jharkhand had changed the name of Palamu district headquarters as Medininagar in the year 2004 though the name of railway station is still Daltonganj;
- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to change the name of Daltonganj railway station and rename it as Medininagar;
- (c) if so, the time by which it is likely to be done; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) : Yes Madam, the State Government of Jharkhand had changed the name of Palamu District headquarters as Medininagar in the year 2004. However, the name of railway station is still Daltonganj.
