NATIONAL MARINE POLICE ACADEMY AT WEST COAST

1015. SHRI DILIPBHAI PANDYA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government intends to set up National Marine Police Academy at West Coast and if so, the details in this regard;

(b) whether Government of Gujarat has offered land and made a representation for this purpose; and

(c) if so, by when this proposed Marine Police Academy will start its operation?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The Government of India has decided to establish a National Marine Police Training Institute in the land offered by the Government of Gujarat located at Pindara village in Devbhoomi Dwarka district of the State, to impart training to the marine Police personnel of all the coastal States/Union Territories in the country.

(c) It will take, at least, 4 years to operationalise this Institute.
