EX-GRATIA PAYMENT TO FAMILIES OF DECEASED PARA-MILITARY
PERSONNEL

1037. SHRI RAJEEV SHUKLA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) how many para-military personnel have been killed in naxal insurgency and counter insurgency operations during the year 2014;
- (b) the families of how many of those killed personnel have already been provided *ex-gratia* payment; and
- (c) how much amount is pending and by when they will be released?

ANSWER

(a): As reported by the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and Assam Rifles, 56 personnel have been killed in naxal insurgency and counter insurgency operations during the year 2014.

(b) & (c): Ex-gratia lump sum compensation of Rupees 15 lakh has been paid to the Next of Kin (NoKs) of 50 deceased CAPFs & AR personnel. 06 cases (Central Reserve Police Force-02 & Assam Rifles-04) of ex-gratia lump sum compensation amounting to Rupees 90 lakh are pending due to non receipt of required documents from the NoKs i.e. Succession Certificate from the Court and other required documents as per rule.
