KILLING OF ABDUCTED POLICEMEN BY MAOISTS IN CHHATTISGARH

1835. SHRI A.K. SELVARAJ:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Maoists killed four abducted policemen in Chhattisgarh recently, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that the State Government has failed to secure the release of these abducted policemen; and
- (c) if so, whether Government has sought any report from the State Government?

ANSWER

(SHRI HARIBHAI PARATHIBHAI CHAUDHARY)

(a): On 13.07.2015, Left Wing Extremists abducted 04 Assistant Constables during vehicle checking on the road between villages Saknapalli and Kutru, Bijapur, Chhattisgarh and took them away into the jungle. On 15.07.2015, dead bodies of four abducted Assistant Constables were recovered near village Gudma, Chhattisgarh.

(b): State Government of Chhattisgarh has informed that on receipt of information, Security Forces launched search operations to locate the abducted Assistant Constables. Besides, help of civil society, Press and families of abductees was also mobilized for release of abducted Policemen.

(c): The Ministry of Home Affairs took immediate cognizance of the incident and sought feedback on the incident from the Government of Chhattisgarh. The Ministry of Home Affairs has also requested Government of Chhattisgarh to accord priority to the investigation of this case.
