AMENDMENTS IN Cr.PC FOR SPEEDY TRIAL OF CASES

674. SHRIMATI RAJANI PATIL :

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to bring about amendments in the Criminal Procedure Code for speedy trial of cases;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any proposal is under consideration of Government to tighten the existing procedure and practices being often resorted to by the concerned to delay the hearings in the courts; and
- (d) if so, the details in this regard?

(a) to (d): No Sir, there is no proposal to bring amendments in the Criminal Procedure Code for speedy trial of cases at present. Amendment in criminal law as per the social and legal requirements is a continuous process. Similarly, administrative measures are taken by the Executive and Judicial authorities for proper implementation of the law/procedures in order to curtail delays in the court hearings, etc.
