BLUE PRINT OF SMART POLICE STATIONS

678. SHRI S. THANGAVELU:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the blue print of a SMART police station for smart policing is ready;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that each police station designed by the Bureau of Police Research and Development will cost anywhere from Rs. 4.2 crore to Rs. 7.0 crore depending on the location of the station;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether it is also a fact that the entire amount for setting up of such SMART police stations across the country shall be borne by the Central Government?

(a): Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D) has drafted a concept paper for this purpose.

(b) & (c): As per above concept paper the estimated cost of a Smart/Modern Police Station for Metro City is Rs. 7.30 crore, for City Rs. 6.74 crore, for Semi-Urban area Rs. 4.56 crore and for Rural area Rs 4.02 crore.

(d): In 2015-16 Central funding under plan component of Modernisation of Police Force (MPF) Scheme has been discontinued.
