ADEQUATE STRENGTH OF TOP POLICE PERSONNEL

1000. DR. V. MAITREYAN:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government has adequate strength of top police personnel (IPS cadre or equivalent) State/UT-wise to manage our vast police force in the country;

(b) if so, the State/UT-wise details thereof and total vacancies to be filled;

(c) the steps taken by the Union Government to strengthen the police force with sufficient State intelligence and security agencies to facilitate timely action; and

(d) the total funds earmarked for strengthening of police force in the country during the Twelfth Plan?

ANSWER

(a): There are 3848 IPS officers available in the Country as on 01.01.2015 which are sufficient in number to man the important assignments to manage police force across the Country.

(b): The state-wise vacancy position and in position strength of IPS officers in Indian Police Service as on 01.01.2015 is annexed at Annexure "A".

(c): The Union Government has strengthened the intelligence functions of IB by creating additional posts. In 2008, Government sanctioned 2102 posts in IB under various schemes like Grass root intelligence, Counter Terrorism/Operation, Cyber Cell, Economic- Intelligence, Subsidiary Multy

Agency Centre /Joint Intelligence Committee etc. Simultaneously, Government sanctioned 217 posts for augmentation of the strength of Joint Task Force on Intelligence (JTFI), Multi Agency Centre (MAC) and Inter State Intelligence Support Team (ISIST). In 2009, Government sanctioned 77 posts for setting up of Research and Technology Centre in IB. During the last six years, in addition, over four thousand posts have been sanctioned for Bureau of immigration. Sanctioned & Actual Vacancy position of IPS Officers as on 22.07.2015 is appended at Annexure "B".

(d): The requirement of Funds for MPF Scheme during 12th plan period (from 2012-13 to 2016-17) approved by Cabinet Committee on Security under non-plan is Rs. 8628.43 crore and under plan is Rs. 3750.87 crore.
