STEPS TAKEN TO CRACK DOWN ALL ISIS/ EXTREMIST MODULES

1907. SHRI B.K. HARIPRASAD:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the NIA has cracked any ISIS module in Hyderabad;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the details of steps taken to crack down all the ISIS/extremist modules existing in the country?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) : The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has registered a case to investigate the allegations that some youth and their accomplices have entered into a criminal conspiracy to wage war against the Government of India and were collecting weapons and

explosive material to target public places including religious sites etc., in various parts of the country. NIA has so far arrested seven persons from Hyderabad in this case.

(d): In order to counter terror activities, there exists a close and effective coordination between intelligence and security agencies at the Centre and the State levels. This has resulted in busting of several terrorist modules including ISIS/ISIL cadres, by the Security Agencies.
