FUNDS UNDER SCHEME FOR MODERNISATION OF PRISONS, PHASE-II

The details of the programmes and the work to be undertaken under the Scheme for Modernisation of Prisons, Phase-II and the work and the funds (grants) sanctioned, State-wise including Madhya Pradesh?

A consolidated Memorandum, which included the demands projected by States/UTs amounting to Rs. 13,962.60 crore for the second phase of modernization of prisons, was submitted to the 14th Finance Commission. However, the 14th Finance Commission did not make any allocation for this purpose. Since no funds have been provided for the scheme, the second phase of Modernisation of Prisons has not been launched.
