CANCELLATION OF LICENCES OF NGOS

352. SHRI NARANBHAI J. RATHWA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) the number of NGOs whose licences have been cancelled for violating the rules under Foreign Contribution Regulation Act, 2010 during last three years and whether the heads of such NGOs have been awarded with any punishment or they have been released only after being penalised;

(b) the reaction of Government in this regard; and

(c) the details of the above-mentioned NGOs whose heads have been awarded with the punishment or penalised/prosecuted?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) to (c) The registrations of 4873 NGOs have been cancelled during last three

years for violation of provisions of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010

(FCRA, 2010) and rules made there under.

For grave & serious violations, the cases of NGOs are forwarded to the

prosecuting agencies as per the provisions of the FCRA, 2010.

The case of "Advantage India, New Delhi" has been referred to CBI for prosecution.
