(a) to (c): Foreigners Tribunals (FTs) in Assam operate under the provisions of Foreigners Act, 1946 and Foreigners (Tribunal) Order, 1964. At present, 283 FT members and 621 employees are working in FTs in Assam. Of these 163 are permanent and 741 are contractual appointees. There is no deputational employee working in FTs in Assam.
