STATEHOOD TO JAMMU AND KASHMIR

1196. SHRI ELAMARAM KAREEM:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Minister of Home Affairs had stated in Parliament that the Statehood to the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir would be restored, if so, by when, and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether the Delimitation Commission's recommendations in respect of Union Territory has been notified, if not, by when the same will be notified; and
- (c) by when the Assembly elections in J&K will be conducted?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

- (a): Yes Sir. Statehood to Jammu and Kashmir would be granted at an appropriate time.
- (b): Delimitation Commission has notified orders on 14th March, 2022 and 5th May, 2022 on delimitation of Parliamentary and Legislative Assembly Constituencies of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir.
- (c): The decision to conduct elections is the prerogative of the Election Commission of India.
