(a) & (b): The details of awards schemes/incentive schemes being run by the Department of Official Language are given at Annexure-1. Steps have been taken by the Department of Official Language to promote Hindi in the Ministries/Departments of the Central Government. Hindi is being promoted in the Ministries/Departments through motivation, encouragement and technology. The above mentioned awards are being given by the Department of Official Language at the National/Regional/Individual level every year for those who do excellent work in Hindi, which motivates them to work in Official Language.

In accordance with the guidelines issued by the Department of Official Language in recent years, steady progress has been noticed in the use of Hindi in

the official work by the Ministries/Departments. The Annual Assessment Report pertaining to the compliance of the Annual Program is laid every year on the Table of both the Houses of Parliament.

1. Rajbhasha Kirti Awards Scheme

Under the Rajbhasha Kirti Award Scheme, every year shields are awarded to various Ministries/Departments, Public Sector Undertakings, Nationalised Banks, Boards/Autonomous Institution, Town Official Language Implementation Committees, House Magazines for their outstanding achievements in promoting the Official Language Policy of the Government, whose details are as follows:

2. Rajbhasha Gaurav Award Scheme

2.1 Rajbhasha Gaurav Original Book Writing Award Scheme (For Central Government Officials)

Under this scheme, awards are given for writing original books in Hindi to serving or retired personnel in the Central Government. The details of the award are as follows:

Second Prize	₹75,000, a Certificate and a memento
Third Prize	₹60,000, a Certificate and a memento

2.2 Rajbhasha Gaurav Original Book Writing Award Scheme (For Citizens of India)

Under this scheme, awards are given for writing original books in Hindi to the Citizens of India. The details of the awards are as follows:

Second Prize	₹1,25,000, a Certificate and a memento

2.3 Rajbhasha Gaurav Award Scheme for excellent articles published in journals and magazines by Central Government officials.

Under this scheme, awards are given to the officers/employees of the Central Government for excellent articles published in journals and magazines. Under this scheme, authors of excellent articles are given three awards in two categories – i.e. Hindi and Non Hindi, whose details are as follows:

For Hindi Authors

Award	Prize Money
First Prize	₹20,000, a Certificate and a memento
Second Prize	₹18,000, a Certificate and a memento
Third Prize	₹15,000, a Certificate and a memento

For Non- Hindi Authors

Award	Prize Money

3. Rajbhasha Regional Awards Scheme.

Under the Rajbhasha Regional Award Scheme every year shields are awarded to various Central Government offices, subordinate offices of Nationalized Banks, Public Sector Undertakings and Town Official Language Implementation Committees for their outstanding achievements in promoting the Official Language Policy of the Government. These awards given in the East & North East Region (Kolkata/Guwahati), Middle and West Region (Bhopal/Mumbai), North-1 and North-2 Region (Delhi/Ghaziabad) and South & South West (Kocchi/Bengluru). The total number of these awards given every year is 192.

4. Encouragement such as personal pay and incentives for employees of Central Government for passing examinations of Hindi teaching scheme.

4.1 **Personal Pay:** With a view to encouraging Central Govt. officers/ employees an incentive/Personal pay equivalent to one increment for 12 months is given on Hindi Language, Hindi Typewriting and Hindi Stenography Examination.

4.2 **Cash prizes:** The following Cash prizes are given to employees who pass Hindi Prabodh, Hindi Praveen, Hindi Pragya , Hindi Word Processing/ Hindi Typing and Hindi Stenography examinations with good marks-

(i) Prabodh

(ii) Praveen

5. Incentive schemes run by other Ministries/Departments

5.1 Incentives for Stenographers and Typist for doing official work in Hindi other than English

There is a provision to grant an incentive of Rs. 240/- and Rs 160/- per month for Stenographers and Hindi Typist who do their official work in Hindi other than English.

5.2 Incentive for doing official work (noting/drafting) originally in Hindi.
