## Application Under RTI Act, 2005

Under the provisions of Right to Information Act, 2005 I request the MHA to provide me information.

- per Ministry of Finance. Department of Expenditure. Implementation Cell, OM No. F.No.1/1/2008-IC, dated 13th November, 2009, Sixth Pay Commission recommended the merger of the three prerevised scales of Rs.5000-8000, Rs. 5500-9000 and Rs. 6500-10500 and replaced them by the revised pay structure of grade pay of 4200 in the pay band PB-2 in scale Rs.9300-34800. It was also recommended that on account of the merger of these 3 scales, some posts which constituted feeder and promotion grades would come to lie in an identical grade. It was recommended to grant higher grade pay of Rs.4600 to some categories of these posts. As regards the other posts, it was recommended that it should be first seen if the posts in these 3 scales can be merged without any functional disturbance and if possible, the same should be done. Further, the Commission recommended that in case it is not feasible to merge the posts in these pay scales on functional consideration, the posts in the scale of Rs. 5000-8000 and Rs. 5500-9000 should be merged with the posts in the scale of Rs. 6500-10500 being upgraded to the next higher grade in the next light and the n  $^\prime$ upgraded to the next higher grade in the pay band PB-2 with grade pay of Rs.4600 corresponding to the pre-revised scale of Rs.7450-11500. In case a post already exists in the scale of Rs.7450-11500, the post being upgraded from the scale of 6500-10500 should be merged with the post in the scale of Rs.7450-11500.
  - These recommendations were notified vide para (ii) Section 1 in 3. Parts B and C of the First Schedule to the CCS(RP) Rules 2008. While Part B of the First Schedule to the CCS (RP) Rules relates to the revised pay scales for the common categories of staff, Part C notifies revised pay structure for certain posts in Ministries, Departments and Union Territories. The above provisions of the Rules specifically mentioned that upgradations in terms of para (ii) Section 1 may be done in consultation with Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance.



Department of Expenditure, Implementation Cell, Ministry of Finance Te OM F.No.1/1/2008-IC dated 13<sup>th</sup> Nov,2009 conveys the decision that the posts which were in the pre-revised scale of Rs.6500-10500 as on 1.1.2006 and which were granted the normal replacement pay structure of grade pay of Rs 4200/- in the pay band PB-2 will be granted grade pay of Rs.4600 in the pay band-2 corresponding to the pre-revised scale of Rs.7450-11500/-, the post being upgraded from the scale of Rs.6500-10500 should be merged with the post in the scale of Rs.7450-11500.

## Information Sought Specifically From MHA

1. What action has been taken by the Ministry of Home Affairs to ensure implementation of upgradation of posts in the Central Para Military Forces e.g. CRPF, BSF, ITBP, CISF in the pay scale of Rs.6500-10500/- to pre-revised pay scale of Rs.7450-11500/- in light of the Ministry of Finance OMs dated 13 November, 2009 and Notification of CCS (RP) Rules, 2008,?

2. Out of these CPMFs under administrative and operational control of MHA, which of these CPMFs have already implemented the

upgradation of posts?

3. In case the above said upgradation has not at all been implemented in any of these CPMFs, as per record of MHA what are the reasons for its non-implementation of statutory orders of Govt of India?
