OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Constitution of Security Commission for the Union Territories in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in WP(C) No.310/1996, titled Pakash Singh & Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors.

The undersigned is directed to say that in the light of the recommendations/observations contained in the report submitted by the Justice K. T. Thomas Committee to the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the matter relating to constitution of Security Commission for the Union Territories has been re-examined in this Ministry. Accordingly, in partial modification of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.14040/127/2010-UTP dated 10th January, 2011, it has been decided to keep composition of the Security Commission for Union Territories, other than NCT of Delhi, as under :-

2. The functions of the Commission shall be as prescribed in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. 14040/45/2009-UTP dated the 3rd March, 2010.

3. The tenure of the Independent Members, nominated by the Central Government, shall be for a period of two years. An Independent Member may be removed by the Chairperson of the Commission for reasons to be recorded in writing.

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4. The Independent Members may be paid sitting fee at the rate of Rs.3000/- per sitting subject to the condition that the amount may not exceed Rs.4.8 lakh per annum. They may also be entitled to TA/DA as admissible to the Secretary to the Government of India
5. Necessary provisions regarding Security Commission are being made in the Delhi Police Act. Till the Delhi Police Act is suitably amended, action may be taken in the matter as aforementioned.
