Sub: Registration and Investigation of complaints of criminal offences such as theft, robbery, etc. lodged by Railway passengers-reg.

Sir/Madam,

Offences against Railway passengers like theft, robbery etc. are registered and investigated by Government Railway Police (GRP) of States responsible for prevention, detection and investigation of such crimes. It is necessary that complaints made by Railway passengers for criminal offences are duly registered under the relevant Sections of Indian Penal Code (IPC) and investigated by GRP in order to recover stolen property and punish culprits. Proactive registration of cases/filling of FIRs in such criminal offences and their proper investigation would act as a deterrent for criminals indulging in crime against Railway passengers. It will increase chances of recovery of stolen property, improve the response mechanism thereby raising the satisfaction level of Railway passengers. It would also help Railways administration to appreciate actual crime position and formulate appropriate action plan and policies.

2. In the above background, States/UT Governments are requested to issue necessary instructions to Government Railway Police (GRP) of their State, which will go a long way in ensuring security of passengers on Indian Railways.
