User fee (Toll Collection) across all the National Highways has been resumed w.e.f midnight of 02.12. 2016. To facilitate smooth passage of National Highways users, several measure have been undertaken such as, fee collection through credit/debit cards through point of sale system installed by the banks usage of fee paid instruments, e-wallet, electronic toll collection and acceptance of old currency note of Rs. 500/- till the 15th December,2016 as a special case.

- However, anticipating a scenario of likely shortage of currency notes which may result in longer than normal traffic at the Toll Plaza booths, State Administrations are requested to deploy adequate police forces and Duty Magistrates for facilitating smooth passage of NH users.
- 3 It is requested to ensure the availability and deployment of adequate Officers and Police Forces so that no potential law and order situation arises across the Toll Plazas.
