The Central Bureau of Investigation are having vacancies in the rank of SP to be filled by IPS officers as per IPS Tenure Policy on deputation basis.

2. As per IPS Tenure Policy, the IPS officers who have completed 7 years of service are eligible for deputation to CBI. The normal tenure of deputation at the level of SP is 4 years. IPS officers who are deputed to the CBI and are found to have special aptitude for work in that organisation and whose retention is considered to be in public interest may be allowed a further tenure up to 3 years in addition to the normal tenure subject to a maximum tenure of 7 years. The location of cities/towns where the vacancies in SP level exist is as under:
