Subject : **UNMISS : Deployment of Police Officer (India)**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Director General of Police, Intelligence, Punjab, Chandigarh letter No. 7311/E-2(3) dated 21st April, 2016 on the above subject and to say that United Nations, Department of Peacekeeping Operations (UNDPKO) through Permanent Mission India to UN (PMI to UN) has confirmed selection of Shri Slamudin, Inspector, Punjab Police for deployment to UNMISS on **01st May, 2016**.

2. The officer should bring the following :

- **Travel arrangement** : The new incoming officer should arrive in Entebbe, Uganda, for 1 week pre-deployment induction training. He will proceed to UNMISS (Juba) by UN flight after the completion of the induction training. It is highly recommended to dispatch the accompanying luggage to Juba as the luggage transportation capacity from Entebbe to Juba is limited.
- **VISA** : Please be advised that at the moment, no entry visa is required for the incoming UN Staff.
- **CASH** : He must bring sufficient cash (USD) to sustain one (1) week during the induction in Juba (**USD \$ 100 per day**). He can't expect to receive MSA on the day of arrival and need to be able to pay for food and hotel.
- **Fragmentation vest & helmet**: With reference to the guidelines for UN Police Officers, it is emphasised that he must bring a fragmentation vest and Kevlar helmet for his personal protection. Failure to meet this requirement may result in the denial of the deployment.
- **Vaccination Certificate**: Yellow Fever vaccination is mandatory and proof of immunisation must be produced at entry for all travellers.
- **Malaria**: Malaria Prophylaxis is required. Please see the guidelines for UN Police Officers on assignment with peacekeeping operations and the attached Travel Advisory.

- **In-Mission test in Language & Driving** – He must have at least two years recent driving experience, and must be in possession of valid national or international civilian driving licenses. He must present his valid national driving licence upon arrival in the mission area. The license should be valid during his service. He is subject to in-mission assessment in driving skills and English Language if he has not been cleared by a UN SAAT team. If he fails such assessments, he will be repatriated at his own expense. Alternatively, if he had successfully passed SAAT tests earlier, only his driving skills will be re-examined.
 - **Online courses:** Please be advised that the following online courses are mandatory for the newcomers, and certificates will be needed for check-in formalities upon his arrival. Certificates must be printed upon completion of courses, if a printer is not available, he may be able to log-on at one of the mission computers to print the certificates upon arrival in Entebbe (**links given below**):-

 - ❖ **Prevention of Workplace Harassment, Sexual Harassment, and Abuse of authority in the workplace :** This course requires an individual user profile to be created in Inspira – www.careers.un.org. Once created, select 'Main Menu', followed by ' Self Service' followed by ' Learning' followed by ' My Learning, then 'Browse Catalogue', select ' Working for the UN', and then 'Mandatory Training' and finally the "Prevention of Workplace Harassment, Sexual Harassment, and Abuse of Authority in the Workplace" link.
 - The original receipt certifying depositing of his personal passport with the issuing authority in case of any passport held earlier.
 - NOC/relieving order and Disciplinary/Vigilance clearance from his department at the time of reporting at National UN CIVPOL Centre.
 - Recommended clothing & equipment guide list for assignment with UN Mission in South Sudan.
 - If he fails to accept the offer for appointment, he will be debarred for 03 years for further deployment/detailment with any UN assignments /Foreign courses.
3. The UN only pays subsistence allowance during the period of deployment within UN Mission area. The pay and allowances are to be paid by the lending authority. He may also be allowed to retain Government accommodation/telephone etc., if any held by him.
4. It must be ensured that the he has rendered 08 years of police service including training period and are clear from vigilance angle. He has to compulsorily get the uniform and bear the cost of uniform from his personal saving. They are entitled to carry 100 Kg. total baggages, including hand/Cabin baggage.

5. It is, therefore, requested that **Shri Slamudin, Inspector, Punjab Police** may be relieved to report to the Commandant, National UN CIVPOL Centre, 22nd Bn ITBP by **26th April, 2016** to complete their travel formalities.
