Subject: Action Taken Report (ATR) on action points arising out of recommendations made in the DGsP/IGsP Conference, 2021.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject mentioned above and to say that DGsP/IGsP Conference, 2021 held in November at Lucknow. Some recommendations made in the Conference relates to police stations in border areas. These recommendations are as under:-

- No. 22 "In border areas, block/PSs should be defined and demarcated on basis of geographical locations instead of population density."
- No. 55 "All States should review the number of Police Stations in border areas and set up new PSs. States should also coordinate with IB and other Central agencies on border issues."
- 2. It is therefore, requested that necessary action may be taken on the aforesaid recommendations of the DGsP/IGsP Conference, 2021.
