

He said that if the State government had cooperated in the matter of schemes, then this figure would have reached 3.5 lakh crore. Shri Shah said that the Central Government has given Rs. 1,800 crore for Backward Districts, Rs. 3,300 crore for development of tribal districts out of the District Mineral Fund, Rs. 6,400 crore for Ramagundam Fertilizer Factory and Rs. 1,200 crore for AIIMS Telangana. Rs. 1,200 crore for ESIC Medical Hospital Sanatnagar, Rs. 2,500 crore for Jal Jeevan Mission, Rs. 2,500 crore for Backward Class welfare, Rs. 300 crore for NIPER in Hyderabad and Rs. 43,000 crore for Mudra loan to 52 lakh beneficiaries has been provided.

Also under the Amrit Yojna Rs. 8,000 crore, for Hyderabad Metro Rs. 661 crore, for Railways Rs. 31,281 crore, for regional ring road Rs. 8,000 crore have been spent and under the Sarv Shiksha Abhiyan Rs.1,300 crore have been given. We have never treated Telangana in a step motherly fashion.
