



Driving Test.- Driving test conducted by the examination board to drive heavy vehicle.

Note:- The incumbent whether appointed by direct recruitment or by promotion or whether permanent or quasi-permanent or temporary shall have to go through a course in fire fighting for a period not less than six months from National Fire Service College, Nagpur.

They have to successfully complete the said course within one year from the appointment to the post, otherwise, their increment will be withheld. After completing the said course, the pay shall be re-fixed as if their increment had been
