

(viii) **Union Home Minister's Medal for Excellence in Police Training :**

The medal was instituted vide Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India Notification No.23011/16/2014-PT/PMA dated 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2016 to be conferred on Members of Police Force, Central Police/Security organizations throughout the Indian Union in reorganization of the outstanding service in Police Training Institutes. Union Home Minister is Competent for approval of recommendations to be finalized by the committee. For this purpose Bureau of Police Research and Develop (BPR&D) is Nodal Agency.

**NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, the 11th May, 2016

**F.No.23011/16/2014-PT/PMA.**—The Home Minister is pleased to institute the following award to be conferred on Members of Police Force, Central Police/Security Organizations throughout the Indian Union in recognition of the outstanding service in Police Training Institutes and to make ordain and establish the following Statutes governing them, which shall be deemed to have effect from the twenty sixth day of January in the year two thousand and sixteen.

**UNION HOME MINISTER'S MEDAL FOR EXCELLENCE IN POLICE TRAINING:**

**Firstly:-** The award shall be in the form of a medal styled and designated as the **UNION HOME MINISTER'S MEDAL FOR EXCELLENCE IN POLICE TRAINING** and (hereinafter referred to as medal)

**Secondly :-** The medal shall be circular in shape, made of cupro-nickel, 38 mm in diameter, 3 mm in thickness. On the obverse it shall have embossed the State Emblem in centre. The word "INTEGRITY" shall be embossed below the state emblem. The State emblem shall be encircled by the wreath.

On the reverse the curve legend on the top "विष्णुः शक्तिं ददाति" shall be written. Then in the centre "fo|k/kue l o|kue i/kue" followed by "ifyl if"k{k.k e: mrd!"rk di fy# dn\$; %&e' \$ ind" and below it "fo(kue lo' i)" ;r;" (in Sanskrit) shall be written. In the centre wrapped in wreath three figures shows the weapon, physical instructor (drill instructor is carrying National Flag in hand), book and flame shall be depicted.

**Thirdly:-** Each medal shall be suspended by a 38 mm long horizontal "non- swivelling bar with inscription 'Union Home Minister's Medal for Excellence in Police Training' with a ribbon of 35 mm width with a series of 7 mm stripes; red (with a red worn to the wearers normal right), navy blue, khaki, metallic grey and white.

**Fourthly:-** The names of those to whom this medal may be awarded may be published in Gazette of India and in Register of such names may be kept in the Ministry of Home Affairs by such person as the Union Home Minister will direct.

**Fifthly:-** The medal shall only be awarded to those who have shown outstanding performance for certain minimum number of years in Police Training Institute as per criteria.

**Sixthly:-** It shall be competent for the Union Home Minister to cancel and annul the award to any person of the above medal and that there upon his name in the Register shall be erased. It shall, however, be competent for the Union Home Minister to restore any medal, which may have been so forfeited. Every person to whom the said medal is awarded shall, before receiving the same enter into an agreement, to return the medal if his name is erased as aforesaid. Notice of cancellation or restoration in every case shall be published in the Gazette of India.

**Seventhly:-** It shall be competent for the Ministry of Home Affairs to make rules to carry out the purpose of these Statutes.

In accordance with above Statutes relating to the "UNION HOME MINISTER'S MEDAL FOR EXCELLENCE IN POLICE TRAINING", the following Rules governing the award of the Medal are notified :-

1. Every year up to 167 medals will be awarded under various categories to the member of Police Force, Central Police/ Security Organisation for their outstanding services in Police Training Institute. The State/ Union Territory/ CPO/CAPF wise distribution of medals calculated on the basis of sanctioned strength of each force is enclosed as **appendix A**. At present the number of medals has been calculated on the basis of sanctioned strength as on 01.01.2013. However, the number of medals will be reviewed every three years or whenever there is major change in the strength of Police Force, Central Police/ Security Organisation.

## 2. Categories of Medals:

For the purpose of ensuring the representation of everyone involved in the police training, medals have been divided in the following three categories:

- (a) Indoor
- (b) Outdoor
- (c) Others

## 3. Quota of medals:

- (a) Quota of Medals for States, UTs and CPOs under each category will be as follows:

- I. Indoor – 40%
- II. Outdoor – 40%
- III. Others – 20%

- (b) Quota of Medals for CAPFs under each category will be as follows:

- I. Indoor – 30%
- II. Outdoor – 50%
- III. Others – 20%

- (c) Wherever only indoor training is being provided, the quota of outdoor medal will be merged with indoor Medals.

(d) BPR&D will ensure that nominations are invited as per the above criteria/quota every year.

**4. Eligibility criteria for candidate:**

- (a) The nominee should have completed a minimum of five years of service in the police department.
- (b) Only those officers who have completed minimum two years of service in the training institute continuously as on 1<sup>st</sup> of April of the year of consideration can only be nominated. However, the total length of service in training institute (same or other institute(s)) should not be less than 3 years. The financial year is declared as the year of consideration for the purposes of the award of this Medal.
- (c) No Judicial Proceedings/Departmental Enquiry should have been in pendency or period of punishment should be in currency against the recommendee at the time of considering his/her name for the Medal. The recommendee should not have been given any major/minor penalty in the last five years.
- (d) No vigilance proceedings/departmental enquiry shall be pending or contemplated against the officials.
- (e) The ACR grading of the nominee should be 'Outstanding/very good' at least in 3 years out of last 5 years & 'Good' in the remaining 2 years. There should not be any adverse entry in the last 5 years.
- (f) The recommendee should not have been awarded the HOME MINISTER'S MEDAL FOR THE EXCELLANCE IN TRAINING on previous occasion.

**5. Committees for selection of nominees:**

A three tier screening procedure will be followed for selection of the candidates as under:

- A. **Institution level committee:** Will select candidates for nominations and forward the same to the headquarters level committee
- B. **Headquarters level Committee:** shall recommend candidates to the MHA/BPR&D level committee
- C. **MHA/BPR&D Level Committee:** shall make the final selection

The MHA/BPR&D level committee will have the authority to appoint sub-committees for the purpose of final selection of the nominees for assistance.

**6. Certificate and cash reward with the Medals:**

A Certificate (Scroll) signed by the Union Home Minister will be awarded to each winner along with the Medal.

**7. Withdrawal of Medal:**

The Union Home Minister is competent to withdraw the Medal if the holder is found guilty of disloyalty or brings the force to disrepute such as removal, major penalty, criminal offences etc. or any such conduct as may be found unbecoming in the opinion of the Government of the State or the Union as awardee of the Medal.

1. पुलिस बल, केंद्रीय पुलिस/सुरक्षा संगठन के सदस्यों को पुलिस प्रशिक्षण संस्थान में उनकी उत्कृष्ट सेवाओं के लिए विभिन्न श्रेणियों के अंतर्गत प्रति वर्ष 334 तक, पदक प्रदान किये जाएंगे। प्रत्येक बल की स्वीकृत नफरी के आधार पर गणना किए गए पदकों का राज्य/संघ राज्य क्षेत्र/केंद्रीय पुलिस संगठन/केंद्रीय सशस्त्र पुलिस बल-वार वितरण परिशिष्ट 'क' के रूप में संलग्न है। वर्तमान में, पदकों की संख्या की गणना दिनांक 01.01.2013 की स्थिति के अनुसार स्वीकृत नफरी के आधार पर की गई है। तथापि, पदकों की संख्या की समीक्षा हर तीन वर्ष में या पुलिस बल, केंद्रीय पुलिस/सुरक्षा संगठन की नफरी में बड़ा बदलाव होने पर की जाएगी।
