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ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR
NOTIFICATION

Dated Dispur, the 27th September, 2025

No. HMA-19015/9/2019-Political(A)/Pt-1/(eCF-200043)/138 ::

Whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 3 of the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, 1958 (Act No. 28 of 1958), the Government of Assam declared the areas of three districts—Tinsukia, Charaideo, and Sivasagar—as "Disturbed Area" vide notification No. HMA-19015/9/2019-Political(A)/Pt-1/121, dated 30/03/2025, with effect from 01/04/2025, for a period of six months;

Whereas, following the receipt of reports from various security agencies, it has been observed that law and order situation in the state of Assam from the extremist point of view has improved considerably. Further, due to sustained efforts and proactive counter insurgency measures of security forces, the overall security scenario in the state of Assam has significantly improved during the last three years;


And whereas, despite these improvements, there have been sporadic incident committed by suspected ULFA (I) cadres, the only militant group active in the state, alongside movement of groups of ULFA(I), NSCN (K-YA) cadres mainly for the purpose of extortion, subversive activities and recruitment of youths.

Therefore, the Government of Assam recommended that the "Disturbed Area" status under AFSPA be continued for an additional six months in the three districts of Tinsukia, Charaideo, and Sivasagar;

And whereas, the Government of Assam submitted a proposal to the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, through letter No. ECF-200043/135 dated 02/09/2025;

And whereas, the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, in its letter No. 11011/51/2015-NE.V dated 26/11/2025, has communicated its agreement with the State Government's view to retain the "Disturbed Area" status under AFSPA for an additional six months in the three districts of Tinsukia, Charaideo, and Sivasagar, beyond 30th September, 2025;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 3 of the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, 1958, and in continuation of the earlier notification vide No. HMA-19015/9/2019-Political(A)/Pt-1/121, dated 30/03/2025, the Governor of Assam is pleased to declare the areas of Tinsukia, Charaideo, and Sivasagar districts as "Disturbed Area" for an additional period of six months, effective from 01/10/2025, unless withdrawn earlier.


