¹S.R.O. 601, dated the 17th April, 1951.—In pursuance of subsection (1) of article 239 of the Constitution the President hereby directs that the powers of a State Government under sections 20 and 21 of the Drugs Act, 1940 (XXIII of 1940), shall, in the States of Bhopal, Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh, Kutch, Manipur, Tripura and Vindhya Pradesh be exercised by the Chief Commissioners of the
