Sir.

I am directed to refer to your above mentioned RTI application (received in this section on 24.10.2013) under Right to Information Act, 2005.

- 2. As regards point 1: It is informed that as per the present Constitutional arrangement, the 'Police' and 'Public Order' in Delhi are reserved subjects. As such, Delhi Police falls directly under the control of Ministry of Home Affairs. The Police personnel of Delhi Police are paid their salary, allowances, etc. from the budget of Ministry of Home Affairs. Their leave and other rules are governed either by various rules framed under the Delhi Police Act or instructions issued by Government of India from time to time. Its employees upto the rank of Inspectors are governed under the Delhi Police Act 1980.
- 3. As regards points 2&3: So far as, while making recruitment to the group of 'C' & 'D' of Delhi Police is concerned, both the central as well as State list of OBC's are being followed. A copy of necessary letter dated April 16, 2012 is enclosed.
