S.R.O. 1580, dated the 7th August, 1953.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Chief Commissioners of Delhi and Bhopal, shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, discharge the functions of the Central Government under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (XI of 1948) in so far as such functions relate to the fixation of minimum rates of wages payable to employees employed in stone breaking or stone crushing operations carried in any mine situated within their respective States.
