CHIEF COMMISSIONERS OF AJMER AND COORG TO EXERCISE POWERS AND DISCHARGE FUNCTIONS OF STATE GOVERNMENT UNDER THE MUSLIM WAKFS ACT, 1954.



S.R.O. 55, dated the 5th January, 1955.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that subject to his control and until further orders the Chief Commissioners of the States of Ajmer and Coorg shall within their respective States exercise the powers, and discharge the functions, of the State Government under the Muslim Wakfs Act, 1954 (XXIX of 1954).
