GSR _____ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Lok Nayak Jayaprakash Narayan National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Science, Senior Scientific Assistant (Ballistics, Documents, Forensic Photography and Chemistry) Recruitment Rules, 2005, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Scientific Assistant (Ballistics), Senior Scientific Assistant (Documents), Senior Scientific Assistant (Forensic Photography) and Senior Scientific Assistant (Chemistry) in the Lok Nayak Jayaprakash Narayan National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Science under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. ____ (1) These rules may be called the Lok Nayak Jayaprakash Narayan National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Science, Senior Scientific Assistant (Ballistics, Documents, Forensic Photography & Audio-Video Analysis and Chemistry) Recruitment Rules, 2020.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay. _____ The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc. ___ The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.
4. Disqualification. ___ No person, --
- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:
- Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
5. Power to relax. ___ Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. Saving --- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
