विषय: **महिला शांति सैनिकों के लिए तैनाती-पूर्व प्रशिक्षण (20 जून - 16 जुलाई 2026) हेतु नामांकन के संबंध में**

महोदया/महोदय,

मुझे यह सूचित करने का निर्देश हुआ है कि विदेश मंत्रालय द्वारा मिस्र के गृह मंत्रालय, पुलिस अकादमी, ईजिप्शियन पीसकिपीनग ऑपरेशन ट्रेनिंग सेंटर से प्राप्त **तैनाती-पूर्व प्रशिक्षण (Pre-deployment Training)** हेतु आमंत्रण अग्रेषित किया गया है, जो दिनांक **20 जून से 16 जुलाई, 2026** तक **ईजिप्शियन पीसकिपीनग ऑपरेशन ट्रेनिंग सेंटर, काहिरा, मिस्र** में आयोजित किया जाना प्रस्तावित है।

2. उक्त प्रशिक्षण पाठ्यक्रम का उद्देश्य संयुक्त राष्ट्र के कोर प्री-डिप्लॉयमेंट ट्रेनिंग मटीरियल (CPTM) तथा विशिष्ट प्रशिक्षण सामग्री (STM) के अनुरूप पुलिस अधिकारियों की क्षमता निर्माण को विकसित करना तथा महिला शांति रक्षकों को उनके निर्धारित दायित्वों के निर्वहन हेतु तैयार करना है।
3. नामित अभ्यर्थियों के लिए पात्रता मानदंड निम्नानुसार हैं:-
 - (i) अभ्यर्थी की आयु 40 वर्ष से अधिक नहीं होनी चाहिए;
 - (ii) अभ्यर्थी का स्वास्थ्य उत्तम हो तथा प्रशिक्षण पाठ्यक्रम में शामिल व्यावहारिक क्षेत्रीय अभ्यासों में भाग लेने हेतु शारीरिक रूप से सक्षम हो; तथा
 - (iii) अभ्यर्थी को लिखित और मौखिक अंग्रेजी भाषा का अच्छा ज्ञान होना चाहिए (अनुवाद सुविधा उपलब्ध नहीं कराई जाएगी)।
4. मिस्र का गृह मंत्रालय प्रशिक्षण पाठ्यक्रम से संबंधित समस्त व्यय, जिसमें वीजा, हवाई यात्रा, आवास एवं भोजन शामिल है, वहन करेगा। किसी प्रकार का **दैनिक भत्ता (Daily Allowance)** देय नहीं होगा।
5. यह सूचित किया जाता है कि भारत के लिए कोई निश्चित सीट निर्धारित नहीं की गई है। यह आमंत्रण संयुक्त राष्ट्र के सभी सदस्य देशों हेतु खुला है। अभ्यर्थियों को पुलिस सेवा का व्यापक अनुभव होना चाहिए तथा उन्हें अंतरराष्ट्रीय शांति सहायता अभियानों में पुलिस अधिकारी के रूप में सेवा हेतु

चयनित किया गया होना चाहिए। भारत सरकार द्वारा अनुशंसित अभ्यर्थियों का अंतिम चयन **ईजिप्शियन पीसकिपीनग ऑपरेशन ट्रेनिंग सेंटर** द्वारा किया जाएगा।

6. वर्तमान में सक्रिय पुलिस सेवा में कार्यरत **उप पुलिस अधीक्षक/पुलिस अधीक्षक (Dy. SP/SP)** रैंक के पत्र एवं उपयुक्त महिला पुलिस अधिकारियों का नामांकन, **अनुलग्नक-1 एवं II** में उल्लेखित आवश्यक दस्तावेजों सहित, विधिवत हस्ताक्षरित एवं सभी प्रकार से पूर्ण कर **25.05.2026** तक उचित माध्यम से इस मंत्रालय को प्रेषित किए जा सकते हैं।
7. संबंधित मंत्रालयों/विभागों/राज्यों/संघ राज्य क्षेत्रों/संगठनों से **सतर्कता स्वीकृति (Vigilance Clearance)** और **कैडर स्वीकृति (Cadre Clearance)** (सभी अधिकारियों हेतु) के बिना प्राप्त नामांकन पत्रों को संक्षिप्त रूप से अस्वीकार कर दिया जाएगा। केवल उचित माध्यम से प्राप्त आवेदन, अर्थात् गृह विभाग (राज्य) के माध्यम से अथवा संगठन प्रमुख की स्वीकृति तथा AGMUT कैडर अधिकारियों के मामले में संघ राज्य क्षेत्र प्रभाग के माध्यम से प्राप्त आवेदन, विचारार्थ स्वीकार किए जाएंगे।

Subject: **Nomination of Pre-deployment Training for Women Peacekeepers, training course (20th June – 16th July 2026) – reg.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform that the Ministry of External Affairs has forwarded an invitation received from the Egyptian Ministry of Interior, Police Academy, Egyptian Peacekeeping Operations Training Centre for the Pre-deployment Training scheduled to be held at the Egyptian Peacekeeping Operations Training Centre, Cairo, Egypt from **20th June to 16th July 2026**.

2. The aim of the course is to develop the capacity building of police officers in accordance with the UN Core Pre-deployment Training Materials (CPTM) and the Specialized Training Materials (STM), to prepare women peacekeepers to perform their mandated duties.
3. The eligibility criteria for nominated candidates are as under:-
 - (i) Must not exceed **40 years of age**;
 - (ii) Must be in good health and fit physical condition to undertake practical field exercises included in the training course; and
 - (iii) Must be fluent in written and spoken English (no translation facility shall be provided).
4. The Egyptian Ministry of Interior shall bear all expenses related to the training course including **visa, air tickets, accommodation and meals**. No daily allowance shall be paid.
5. It is informed that no fixed slot has been allotted to India. The invitation is open to all UN Member States. The candidates should possess broad experience in police service and should be selected to serve as police officers in international peace support operations. The final selection of candidates recommended by the Government of India shall be made by the Egyptian Peacekeeping Operations Training Center.
6. Nomination of eligible and suitable **women police officer in the rank of Dy SP/SP**, presently in active police service, may be forwarded through proper channel to this Ministry by 25.05.2026, along with requisite documents duly signed and completed in all respects as prescribed in **Annexure – I & II**.

7. The nominations received without **Vigilance clearance** and **Cadre Clearance** (for all Officers) from respective Ministries/Departments/States/UTs/Organizations shall be summarily rejected. Applications received through proper channel only i.e. through **Home Department (State)/ approval of Head of Organization/UT division in case of AGMUT cadre officers**, shall be considered.

8. The duly completed and signed **Bio-data in prescribed proforma, Registration form and HR certificate**, along with the forwarding letter including **APAR/ACR gradings for the Last Five Years (Mandatory)** of nominated officers, are required to be submitted in a **single PDF file only** through email at **police2-un@mha.gov.in** before the prescribed last date.

9. As part of the **Digital India initiative**, all requisite documents are to be submitted only through digital mode at the above-mentioned email address. No hard/physical copies are required.

CONCEPT NOTE

Pre-deployment Training for Women Peacekeepers, training course (20th June – 16th July 2026).

Introduction

The Egyptian Peacekeeping Operations Training Center **EPOTC** affiliated to the Police Academy will conduct a Pre-deployment training course for Women peacekeepers, from 20th June to 16th July 2026.

Realizing the need for standardized and unified training for women Peacekeepers from various countries to work in peacekeeping operations. In conflict and post-conflict areas, women and children are the first victims. therefore, the participation and presence of Women Peacekeepers in peace operations makes the peacekeeping force more approachable to women and children. especially, in Gender-Based Violence cases.

Based on the previous fact and the developing important role of women Peacekeepers as inspiration to women and girls in the local communities. The role of women in peace missions and conflict zones is revealed and outlined in this training course to develop a better understanding of the essential role that women Peacekeepers perform.

Stemming from our commitment towards the capacity building of police officers, EPOTC developed this training course in accordance with the UN Core Pre-deployment Training Materials (CPTM) and the Specialized Training Materials (STM), to prepare women peacekeepers to perform their mandated duties.

In view of the above, the Egyptian Police Academy would like to extend an invitation to your government to nominate officers to attend this course.

A. Course Objectives

Training women peacekeepers to perform their mandated duties according to principles, guidelines, and policies of the UN peacekeeping and equip them with the necessary skills and knowledge to work in a standardized and integrated manner with other components in the mission, and also cover the following topics:-

- Capacity building and development of local police in the host country.



- Operational support of the local police.
- Police operations and tactics (public order management – checkpoints - patrols ...)
- Tactical training (shooting - land navigation - 4x4 vehicle driving ...)
- Protection of civilians.
- Community-oriented policing.
- The role of women in peace and security
- Serving in Peace Operations for women peacekeepers
- Recruitment and training of female police officers
- Gender based violence in armed conflicts &
- Sexual Exploitation and Abuse

B. Target Audience

The course targets the following categories:

- Women Police officers nominated for future deployments in field peacekeeping operations under the flag of the United Nations.
- women peacekeepers assigned as Gender, Human Rights, and Women & Child protection officers.
- Women Police personnel trainers in their respective countries

C. Training Methodology

The training methodology will comprise 30% theoretical adult-based learning and 70% field training exercises with a full range of practical and interactive lesson delivery methods to encourage active participation.

D. Administrative and Logistic Support

The Egyptian Ministry of Interior will cover all the training course costs including visas, flight tickets, accommodation, and meals (No daily allowance will be paid).

E. Venue

The course will be held at The Egyptian Peacekeeping Operations Training Center EPOTC located in the Police Academy, Cairo, Egypt.
All course participants will be accommodated at The Waha Hotel inside the Police Academy premises.



F. Course Date / duration

The course will be held from 20th June to 16th July 2026. The duration of the course is 4 weeks (28 days including 4 weekends)

G. Language of the course

The official language of the course is English, all participants must be fluent in written and spoken English (no translation provided).

H. Nomination and selection

The nomination of 2 female police officers (1 of them as a reserve) is requested.

The candidates must not exceed 40 years old in good health and in a fit physical condition that qualifies them to perform the practical field exercises included in the training course.
