The Integrated Training Service (ITS) of the Division of Policy, Evaluation and Training (DPET), Department of Peace Operations (DPO), in partnership with the Kingdom of Morocco, will conduct a Training of Trainers Course for the Reinforcement Training Package (RTP) for the UN Military and Formed Police Units on Addressing Misinformation, Disinformation and Hate Speech (MDH) Threats in the UN Peace Operations in Rabat, Morocco from 03-14 November 2025. The course, to be conducted in English, aims to enhance the capabilities of UN Member States in delivering the reinforcement training package for United Nations Military and Formed Police Units deployed to UN missions.
- 3. All costs related to round-trip air tickets, accommodation, and meals for the participants will be covered by the Organizers. Participants must have health insurance while attending the course. The Host (Moroccan) Authorities will provide medical support for minor ailments (first aid). Before traveling to Morocco, participants must ensure, they have obtained the mandatory health insurance coverage. The responsibility for obtaining all necessary visas, both in terms of costs and administrative procedures, lies solely with the participant's government. Participants must secure all required transit and entry visas before traveling.
- 3. **No fixed slot from India is available. It is an open invitation for all members' states of UN.** The candidates should have a broad experience of police service, and are selected to serve as a police officer in an international peace support operation. The recommended nominees by Government of India will be selected by the UN. The selection process considers a balance in professional and organizational backgrounds.

The nomination of eligible and suitable candidates in the rank of **SP** active in police service for the above said courses may be forwarded through proper channel to this Ministry **by 18 September 2025** along with the requisite documents duly signed and completed in all aspects as mentioned in Annexure-I & II. The nominations without Vigilance clearance and

Cadre Clearance (for all Officers) from respective Ministries/Departments/State or UT/Organizations' shall be summarily rejected. Applications received through proper channel only i.e. through Home Department (State)/ approval of Head of Organization/ UT division in case of AGMUT cadre officers, will be entertained. **Applications received after the deadline specified i.e. 18.09.2025 will not be considered.**
