- 1. In full compliance with the United Nations Security Council Resolutions on Women, Peace and Security, the United Nations Police Division is undertaking all measures to increase the number of women police officers in peace operations and to integrate the different concerns and vulnerabilities of women, men, boys and girls into the design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of all police activities. The United Nations Uniformed Gender Parity Strategy (UGPS) initiative, launched in 2018 and covering 2018-2028, sets specific targets for women police personnel in different roles to ensure the uniformed components of peacekeeping are diverse and inclusive, reflecting the communities UN peace operations serve.
- 2. In order to meet the abovementioned targets, the United Nations Police Division has undertaken, during the last years, a number of projects, in close coordination with the United Nations Member States and field misions. While a tangible progress was observed, more should be done to achieve gender parity goals among UNPOL field and Headquaretrs components.
- 3.
