## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Extension of date for inviting suggestions/comments from general public on Proposed Amendments to the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969.

Registration of Births and Deaths in India is mandatory with the enactment of Registration of Births and Deaths (RBD), Act 1969. The Act is around 50 years old and has not been amended so far. Various Sections of the Act are proposed to be amended to make it people friendly and to accommodate changes and new developments in the society during the last five decades.

The Office of Registrar General, India (ORGI), Ministry of Home Affairs, initiated the process of amendment of the Act in consultation with concerned Union Ministries / Departments and States / UTs Governments. The suggestions / comments, received from them, have been taken into account while formulating the proposed amendments. This office has invited suggestions/comments, in the prescribed format from general public on proposed amendments to Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 via email (drg-crs.rgi@nic.in), vide Notice dated 18<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2021 within 30 days from the date of its publication on the website/public forum (i.e. latest by 17<sup>th</sup> November ,2021).

The last date for receiving suggestions/comments has now been extended up to 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2021.
