NOTIFICATION
MEDICINAL AND TOILET PREPARATIONS

NO. 15 In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution, the President hereby directs that the Administration of the Union territory of Dadra and Nagar Haveli shall, subject to the control of the President and until further orders, exercise the powers of the collecting Government under clause (d) of section 2 (namely, to empower any person to exercise all or any of the powers of an excise officer), and under section 4 (namely, to grant, in the circumstances stated therein, rebate of duty), of the Medicinal and Toilet Preparations (Excise Duty) Act, 1955 (16 of 1955), within that Union territory.

2. The notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. S.C. 118, dated the 1st January, 1968 published in the Gazette of India, Part II, Section 3, sub-section (ii), dated the 13th January, 1968, is hereby cancelled.
