

S. O. 108, dated the 14th February, 1958.—In pursuance of clause (1) of article 239 of the Constitution and in supersession of all previous notifications on the subject in so far as they relate to the Acts mentioned below, the President hereby directs that the Lieutenant-Governor of Himachal Pradesh, the Chief Commissioners of Delhi, Manipur, Tripura and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and the Administrator of the Laccadive, Minicoy and Amindivi Islands shall, subject to the control of the President, exercise the powers and discharge the functions of the State Government under the following Acts within their respective Union territories:—

1. The Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923 (8 of 1923).
2. The Payment of Wages Act, 1936 (4 of 1936).
3. The Employment of Children Act, 1938 (26 of 1938).
4. The Weekly Holidays Act, 1942 (18 of 1942).
5. The Dock Workers (Regulation of Employment) Act, 1948 (9 of 1948).
6. The Factories Act, 1948 (63 of 1948).
