Sub: Global Tender Enquiry No. D/21013/3284/19/08.07.2019/PW Dated 31.07.2019 Floated on CPP Portal and Opened on 06.09.2019 for Supply, Installation and Commissioning of "Brian Finger Printing / Brain Electrical Oscillation Signature Technology" Qty.01 unit for Central Forensic Science Laboratory CBI, New Delhi.

A GTE dated 31.07.2019 was floated on CPP Portal and was opened on 06.09.2019 (Tech Bid). The two firms viz. i) M/s Velankani Information Systems Ltd. and ii) M/s Axxonet System Technologies Pvt. Ltd. participated against the tender enquiry.

- 2. Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC) under the Chairmanship of Director, CFSL CBI, carried out technical evaluation of the bids submitted by the above two firms against the equipment mentioned in the tender enquiry. The TEC thoroughly examined the Qualification Criteria, eligibility criteria and evaluated the techno-commercial parameters of the bids documents submitted by both the above mentioned firms for their quoted items against the tender enquiry as per the Tender conditions. During evaluation the TEC unanimously decided to go for the field trial/ demonstration of both the firms for their quoted items from 06.11.2019 to 07.11.2019 at CFSL CBI, Block No. 4, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003.
- 3. The TEC examined the respective equipment offered by both the participating firms against the tender enquiry to check the parameters as mentioned in the technical specifications of the GTE and the Corrigendum issued (if any). The following observations were made by the technical experts during the field trial:
