I am directed to enclose herewith draft training program received from MEA on the subject cited above and to inform that MEA is organizing the United Nations Police Pre-Deployment Training (UNPOL-PDT) scheduled from 09 to 20 March 2026 at Manekshaw Centre, New Delhi in partnership with the Centre for UN Peacekeeping (CUNPK).

2. In this regard, MEA has requested this Ministry to nominate 05 Indian Police Officers (IPOs) of CAPF from UN SAAT Panel for participating in the training in the rank of Dy SP to SSP and 02 qualified instructors from Police having a tenure in UNPKO or those who attended a training of trainers course in UN Pre-Deployment training at an institution recognized by UN as the second week of training is on Police aspects of UNPKO.

3. **Administrative arrangement for students/instructors:-** Officers attending the course as instructor and students will be on official duty for the duration of the course and are self-contained for accommodation and transportation. Therefore, no provision in financial outlay exists for the Indian Police Officers who would be attending the course.

WEF 09 MAR 2026 TO 20 MAR 2026

Introduction

1. The Centre for United Nations Peacekeeping (CUNPK) has been directed by UNP Div, MEA to conduct International United Nations Police (UNPOL) Pre Deployment Training wef 09 Mar to 20 Mar 2026 at Manekshaw Centre, New Delhi.

Aim

2. The aim of the course is to prepare Individual and Formed Police Unit officers for effective execution of their tasks as part of UNPOL and to train them for training their unit in UN Peacekeeping techniques.

Objectives


3. The course is designed to enable Police officers to function effectively within the UN environment. On completion of the Course, the officers will be competent to:-

- (a) Fulfill Police aspects of UN Peace Operations mandates in accordance with DPO/DOS principles and guidelines and their underlying international legal standards.
- (b) Perform their Police functions in an effective, professional, and integrated manner.
- (c) Demonstrate the core values and competencies of the United Nations.

4. **Conduct.**

(a) **Trq Curriculum & Programme.** The course has been designed for Police officers of CAPF from various friendly foreign Countries to be deployed in UN missions in various capacities. A training programme will be designed utilizing updated CPTM 2024 and STM for UN Police 2021. The training methodology will include class room lectures, talks by subject matter experts, brainstorming on case studies and breakout sessions. The course will cover structure and organisation of UN missions, peculiar operational environment, relevant mandate and rules of engagement, mission briefs, humanitarian issues and mandated role and tasks of UNPOL. Draft training programme is attached.

(b) **Instructors and Conducting staff.** An instructional team comprising four IA instructors and two instructional staff from CAPF/ MHA will be incorporated for the subject capsule. Apart from instructors, guest speakers shall be invited to deliver talks on contemporary UN peacekeeping challenges and other relevant issues.




5. **Suggested Participants.** 15 International Police offrs and 05 Indian CAPF offrs. A draft proposal for budgetary support is att.
