ORDER

Whereas, the CAT, Principal Bench, New Delhi while disposing of OA No.4244/2012 filed by Shri S. K. S. Yadav, vide order dated 13.08.2018, inter-alia, directed the respondents as under:-

"We, therefore dispose of the O.A. by directing the respondents no. 1 & 3 i.e. the Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs and the Secretary, Deptt. of Personnel & Training respectively to pass orders on the representation dated 22.08.2012 submitted by the applicant within a period of 6 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order."

- 2. Whereas, Shri Yadav had submitted his representation dated 22.08.2012, requesting this Ministry to grant him (i) JAG-II w.e.f. 01.07.1998 (after completion of 13 years of approved service) as has been given to 71 junior officers after completion of 13 years vide order dated 29.02.2012; and (ii) JAG-I Scale w.e.f. 01.07.2003 after completion of 18 years of approved service. In this regard, vide letter dated 29.11.2012, he had given reminder to this Ministry.
- 3. Whereas, before adverting to the merits of the contentions raised in his representation dated 22.08.2012, it may be appropriate, to briefly mention the background facts. These are:-
- 3.1 Shri S.K.S. Yadav was selected in DANICS on the basis of CSE, 1984 and joined the service on 28.04.1986. Approved service in respect of him is counted w.e.f. 01.07.1985.
- 3.2 As per DANICS Rules; candidature for promotion to SG, JAG-II & JAG-I grades is considered on completion of 08 years, 13 years and 18 years of approved service, subject to availability of vacancies in that grade and also subject to Vigilance clearance etc.
- 3.3. Shri Yadav was promoted to Selection Grade; vide order dated 07.08.1995 w.e.f. 23.11.1994.
- 3.4. Before notification dated 06.08.2003, there were 03 grades in DANICS i.e. Grade-II, Grade-I and Junior Administrative Grade (JAG).

Vide notification dated 06.08.2003, Entry Grade, Selection Grade, JAG-II and JAG-I Grades were introduced w.e.f. 01.01.1996. Thus, vide this notification dated 06.08.2003, Grade-II was renamed as Entry Grade, Grade-I was renamed as Selection Grade, JAG was renamed as JAG-II and JAG-I was introduced as a new grade, w.e.f. 01.01.1996.

- 3.5. All the eligible officers in Grade-I (Selection Grade) were promoted to JAG (JAG-II), vide notification dated 21.02.2003, with immediate effect, as per the provisions of DANICS Rules, 1996.
- 3.6 Records shows that a meeting of the DPC to consider promotion to the grade of JAG-II was convened on 11.11.2002 and based on the recommendations of DPC, orders of promotion were issued vide notification dated 21.02.2003. It includes the name of Shri S.N. Mishra at S. No. 10, i.e. immediate junior of Shri Yadav (Annexure-A). Record also shows that on the date of DPC and also on the date of issuance of order of promotion Shri Yadav was not clear from vigilance angle. It is by virtue of the fact that disciplinary proceedings, as were initiated against him vide Memorandum of Charge dated 15.04.1999 and vide Memorandum of Charge dated 25.08.1999 were pending against him. Therefore, recommendations of the DPC in respect of Shri Yadav were kept in sealed cover.
- 3.7 Subsequently while disposing of the OA No.2756/2008 filed by Shri Yadav the CAT (PB) vide its order dated 10.12.2010, inter-alia, directed the respondents to open the 'Sealed Cover' and act on recommendations of the DPC.
- 3.8 In compliance with the directions of Hon'ble Tribunal, vide notification dated 21.04.2011, Shri Yadav was promoted to JAG (JAG-II) on notional basis w.e.f. the date from which his junior Shri S. N. Mishra was promoted i.e. w.e.f. 21.02.2003. Back-wages were allowed from 28.08.2006, when second DE against him was closed. It was also mentioned in the notification that he would be eligible for counting his seniority from the date of his notional promotion, which would also be counted for the purpose of increments.
- 3.9 Record also shows that based on the recommendations of the DPC held on 04.04.2012, 91 JAG-II officers were promoted to JAG-I w.e.f. dated indicated against their named (ranging from 01.07.1996 to 01.07.2011), vide notification dated 17.04.2012 (Annexure-B). It includes the name of Shri S. N. Mishra, immediate junior to Shri Yadav, at S. No. 55. Record shows that Shri Yadav was not clear from vigilance angle on the date of DPC held on 04.04.2012 and also issuance of orders of promotion, i.e. 17.04.2012.

- 3.10 Record also shows that on the date of the DPC held on 04.04.2012 and also on the date of which orders of promotion were issued vide order no. 14016/23/2011-UTS-II dated 17.04.2012, Shri Yadav was not clear from vigilance angle. It is by virtue of the fact that sanction for prosecution was granted to the CBI in case no. RC-14 (A)/2006/CBI/KER dated 29.06.2006, vide letter no. 14033/16/2007-UTS-II dated 25.10.2007 and in case no. RC-12 (A)/2007/CBI/KER dated 30.06.2007, vide letter no.14033/17/2008 dated 20.08.2008. In addition, Vide Memorandum of Charge dated 06.12.2007 and 03.08.2011, 02 departmental proceedings initiated against Shri Yadav in both aforesaid CBI cases, were also pending. Therefore, the recommendations of the DPC in respect of Shri Yadav for promotion to JAG-I were kept in sealed cover. The criminal proceedings in the aforesaid cases continue to be pending before the appropriate court of law.
- 4. Whereas, the contentions raised by Shri Yadav in his representation dated 22.08.2012 are based on conjectures and surmises and are destitute of any illegal force. It is due to the following reasons:-
- 4.1 Presumption of Shri Yadav regarding consideration of his candidature for promotion automatically to the JAG-II and JAG-I of DANICS on completion of 13 years and 18 years respectively is without foundations in law. Consideration of candidature for promotion to various grades is, inter-alia, depending upon the following parameters:-
 - (a) The officer should have completed 13 years and 18 years of approved service in DANICS for attaining eligibility for consideration of candidature for promotion to JAG-II and JAG-I respectively.
 - (b) The officer is found suitable by the Departmental Promotion Committee for promotion;
 - (c) There is a vacancy in the grade in which the officer is to be promoted;
- 4.2. With regard to promotion to JAG-II Grade, it is mentioned that vide order dated 21.04.2011, the officer has already been promoted to JAG-II by the Ministry of Home Affairs w.e.f. 21.02.2003, i.e. with effect from the date from which his juniors were promoted and the date on which occasion arose for consideration of his candidature.
- 5. Whereas, follow up action on the recommendations of the DPCs for consideration of candidature of Shri Yadav for promotion to JAG-I grade, will be taken in terms of extant rules and instructions only after

conclusion of the criminal and also departmental proceedings pending against him as per details in Para-3.10 above.

6. And now therefore, the representations of Shri S. K. S. Yadav dated 22.08.2012 and reminder dated 29.11.2012 stands disposed of accordingly.
