



GSR _____ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to regulate the method of recruitment to the post of Cyber Laboratory Assistant in the Lok Nayak Jayaprakash Narayan National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Science under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. ____ (1) These rules may be called the Lok Nayak Jayaprakash Narayan National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Science, Cyber Laboratory Assistant (Group 'B' post) Recruitment Rules, 2019.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay. ____ The number of the said posts, their classification and the pay level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

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3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc. ____ The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.
4. Disqualification. ____ No person, --
 - (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
5. Power to relax. ____ Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. Saving --- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

<p><u>Deputation (including short term contract):</u> Officers under the Central Government/State Governments/Universities/Recognized Research Institutes/Public Sector Undertakings/Semi-Government, Statutory or Autonomous Organizations:-</p> <p>a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/department; or (ii) with six years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in Pay Level-5 in the Pay Matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre/department; or (iii) with ten years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in posts in Pay Level-4 in the Pay Matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre/department; and b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:</p> <p>Essential:</p> <p>i) Master's degree in Computer Application/Information Technology/Computer Science of a recognized University/Institute; and ii) Two years' experience of electronic data processing/computer programming; or i) Bachelor's degree in Computer Application/Information Technology/Computer Science of a recognized University/Institute; and ii) Three years' experience of electronic data processing/computer programming.</p> <p>Desirable:</p> <p>i) International Certification on Digital Forensics or Networking from Organizations such as International Association of Computer Investigation Specialists (IACIS), EC-Council, Guidance Software, SANS, Access Data, ISC2, ISACA and CISCO. ii) Experience of working in a Cyber/Computer Division or Laboratory.</p> <p>Note-1: Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not exceed 56 years as on the last date for receipt of applications.</p> <p>Note-2: For the purpose of appointment on deputation or absorption basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 (the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.</p>	Not applicable	Consultation with Union Public Service Commission is not necessary for filling up the post and also for amendment of any provisions of these recruitment rules.
