J&K Division	Security Related Expenditure (Police) – SRE (P) Scheme	Rs. 660 crore	Nil	Nil	-	<p>This scheme was introduced in 1989-90 for supporting the logistical requirements of the police force of J&K in order to combat militancy in the State. It provides for 100% reimbursement of expenditure. 60% amount is reimbursed upfront on receipt of claims and remaining 40% is released after receipt of audit report. It broadly covers carriage of constabulary, logistic support for security forces(SFs), honorarium of SPOs, IR battalions, civic action plan for J&K Police, creation and up-gradation of infrastructure like construction of alternate accommodation for security forces so that they can vacate public and private buildings etc.</p> <p>During 2017-18, an amount of Rs. 103.79 crore has been reimbursed to Govt of J&K till 31.05.2017.</p>

J&K Division	Security Related Expenditure (Relief and Rehabilitation) – SRE (R&R) Scheme	Rs. 450 crore	Nil	Nil	-	<p>This scheme was also introduced in 1989-90 for supporting the relief and rehabilitation of the Kashmiri migrants who have been uprooted from the Valley during the militancy period besides other relief & rehabilitation measures. It provides for 100% reimbursement. 60% amount is reimbursed upfront on receipt of claims and remaining 40% is released after receipt of audit report. It broadly covers relief to Kashmiri and Jammu migrants, expenditure incurred on PM's package for return and rehabilitation of Kashmiri migrants, relief to NoKs of civilians/security personnel killed in militant related attacks, rehabilitation of surrendered militants etc.</p> <p>During 2017-18, an amount of Rs. 13.92 crore has been reimbursed to Govt of J&K till 31.05.2017.</p>
